Dear Sir,

You may remember that three years ago - in March 1875 - some correspondence passed between us touching a large collection of Lloyd and Lamb letters which were, and are, in our possession for publication, and I had the pleasure of seeing you here upon the subject. You mentioned that you had letters of Robert Lloyd to Thomas Manning (dated August 20 and 30, September 30 & November 7, 1799, and February 15, March 3, May 26 and June 24 (or July 15) 1800. Those collections are two letters of Thomas Manning to Robert Lloyd, one undated and one belonging to July 1799. A comparison of the letters will probably show that they contain questions & answers. We should be greatly obliged if you would allow us to see, and if necessary to use, copies of Lloyd's letters which are in your hands: and we need hardly say that we would gladly give you the same facilities into our letters from Thomas Manning.

Perhaps you have made other arrangements for publication, but if you have not we should much like to see the manuscript of your Memoir of Thomas Manning: this is very much in the atmosphere just now. Believe me dear Sir,
