Dep Tuesday April 15th 1816

My Dear Brother

I have just received your letter; upon enquiring I find there is no coach sets up at the White Horse Jetter Lane; but I will send the parcel by the Norwich coach tomorrow night, which coach sets up at Swan with two necks Sad Lane - but the parcel I will direct to you at the White Horse, & I trust it will reach you safe - I am sincerely sorry your mind suffers so much from the impediments you meet with, but I do hope you will be rewarded in the end, by all your most sanguine wishes being fulfilled. I will not trouble you with a long letter, which would now be rather unkind than otherwise - William is here & joins us all in fervent prayers for your health & safety - may we soon meet again! God bless you! forever & believe me your ever affectionate
